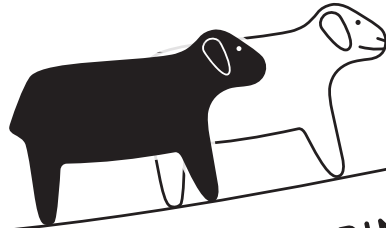
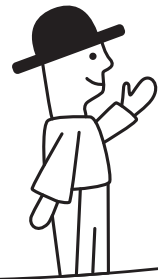


ONE YEAR IN A SHEEP'S LIFE

All the sheep from the mountain villages gather into a big herd. Together with a shepherd and his dog they go to the mountains for five months.



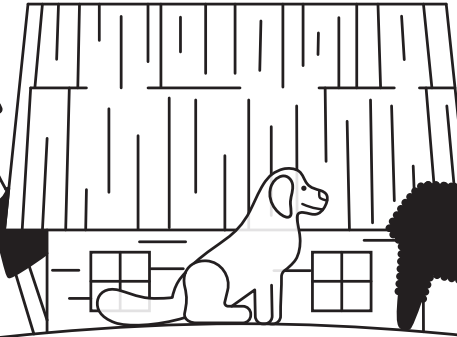
AUTUMN

STRETCHING

Right after cutting it, the fleece is full of dirt. To get rid of it highlanders stretch it by hand and pull the dirt out.

COMBING

To make a thread, the wool is combed. This way it becomes clean and soft.

SPINNING

Finally, they put the wool into a machine called spinning wheel, that turns it into a long thread.
